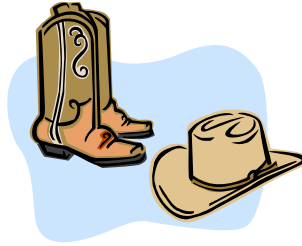


## PTA Meeting May 13th
