SIMPLE WAYS TO BUILD YOUR CHILD'S MATH FOUNDATION

- *Sort objects by color, shape or size
- *Creat simple patterns with objects by color, shape or size
- *Match same number of objects.(Ex: Match 4 circles & 4 balls)
- *Count 1 to 20 or more
- *Use positional words.(behind, beside,in front, in back, between)
- *Use opposite words.(Big-Little, Hot-Cold, Happy-Sad, In-Out)
